

IMS Summer Fun Programme

Withdrawals:

- Refunds will not be issued to any student who withdraws after registration has been completed and payment has been made to IMS.

Health Precautions:

- Please be assured that IMS maintains a very high standard of cleaning and sanitising for the school premises and the materials in the classroom, and is taking all possible steps to safeguard the health of summer school students and staff. In the interests of protecting our young children, we ask that parents monitor the health of your family and children, and cooperate with us in taking the following measures:
- Do not send children to school if they have symptoms of illness, with or without fever. Such symptoms include respiratory problems, cough, sore throat, headache and general aches or pains. (A temperature over 99.5°F or 37.5°C is considered a fever according to the CHP's guidelines for measuring body temperature.) IMS takes the temperature of every person who enters the school. Only students enrolled in the IMS Summer Fun Programme will be allowed to enter the school. Adults and/or accompanied children will not be allowed to enter the school.
- Please collect an unwell child from IMS immediately and consult your doctor. Kindly inform IMS of the results of this visit.
- Please keep sick children at home until symptoms have improved and fever has subsided. Then, rest for at least 2 more days before returning to IMS.
- Please note that daily RAT and masking requirements will match EDB and CHP guidelines at the time of the programme. All requirements will be confirmed via email one week prior to the programme start date.
- ***Please note that all students must qualify as having 2 vaccination doses to participate in this programme, as per current EDB and CHP guidelines.***

Bussing: For those of you who have indicated an interest in bussing, bus availability and details will be provided directly by the bus company, Castle Brothers, closer to the start of each session. Please note, although the bus company will make their best effort to provide bussing, availability will depend on bussing requests. If you require bussing, please complete the bus registration form linked in the Summer Fun! Application form. The bus company will confirm availability and invoice you directly. ***If you have further bussing inquiries, please contact Castle Brothers, Mr. Robert Mu at 2555-2088 or 9032-7434 directly.***

Please NOTE: There is **no ENTRY** into the **Ma Hang Estate** as this area is reserved for school buses. There is **no STOPPING** and **no PARKING** in the Stanley access points to the Plaza. For children not taking the bus, drop-off is possible at the top of the Stanley Plaza. **Unattended cars can be ticketed.**

The “round-a-bout” at the end of Stanley Road is a double yellow line which means **no STOPPING**. Police will fine cars stopping here. There are no bicycle storage facilities on the campus. Bicycles can be locked at the public racks in Stanley Plaza. Please do not chain them to the fence surrounding the school.

Parking: Parking is **not available** at the Stanley Campus. If you would like to accompany your child into school, please park your car in the Public Parking, which is available in the Stanley Plaza. Parents using the services of a driver are asked to review these parking rules carefully with your driver.

Dress Code: Children can come to the Summer Fun Programme in casual clothes - no school uniform is required.

Allergies: We have asked you to let us know of any allergies in the sign-up form. Please let us know of any further allergy information which may be important in the care of your child.

School Closing: When Hong Kong Schools close due to inclement weather, IMS will close, too. Closings are announced on channels TVB Pearl or RTHK, as well as <http://www.edb.gov.hk>. As always, use your best judgement whether or not to transport a child during poor driving conditions. If the Summer Fun Programme is cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions, prorated refunds will be provided.

By law, the closing policy is categorised by age, and at times younger children in our Summer Programme may not have school, while the older children do. (This difference only occurs before school hour starts).
