



WELCOME BACK TO IMS!

Dear IMS Parents,

We hope you had a lovely summer, and we are looking forward to seeing everyone back next week as we begin a new year together! In preparation, we thought it would be helpful to send you a recap of the critical information you need to start off the year.

Please begin reminding your child that school starts soon, and that they will soon see their friends! You may want to show your child a calendar, and count down the days. This supports their learning process, and adds to the anticipation of beginning school as an exciting event to look forward to. We also recommend that you begin having your child wake up at the appropriate time for school and have a good breakfast in the week before school starts so that you can establish a routine.

Your child will start school on Thursday 18 August. **School hours for ALL returning Casa children on 18 & 19 August will be 8:00am-11:30am.** If your child is in the Full-Day programme, full-day hours (Mon-Fri: 8:00am-2:30pm) will commence from **Monday 22 August.** On Monday 22 August, they will be joined by new, younger friends, for some of whom this will be the first day at school. Speak with your child about school, and all of the fun that the children will be having together when school starts! Your child is now an older child, who will be helping these new, younger friends to feel comfortable in their new environment.

COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

As part of our Covid-19 protocols, the following are the most important steps to take before school starts. Please read these carefully, and also review our [Health and Safety Protocols](#) for a complete set of our Covid measures. We thank you for helping keep our community healthy and safe.

1. Please complete the [Student Health Declaration and Vaccination Form](#) **for each child by 5pm on Friday, 12 August 2022**. If you answer “YES” to any of the questions on the declaration, please refrain from sending your child to school, and contact us by phone to provide more details. In this form we are also asking everyone to once again **provide details of your child’s vaccination status, and upload the latest vaccination record** where applicable so please have it at hand. You must have completed this form prior to your child’s first day.
2. Please have your child complete a **Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) every morning** before coming to school, and if the result is positive, keep your child at home and contact us. If your child has any symptoms of Covid or is feeling unwell or lethargic, please also refrain from coming to school.
3. Please print out this [Updated Daily Temperature and RAT Form](#). In the form, **you must do the following daily**:
 - Fill in your child’s temperature before you leave home
 - Check that you are re-affirming the Health Declarations made in #1 above
 - Sign to confirm that your child has a negative result from the RAT for that day.

PLEASE NOTE THAT IF THE RAT CELL IS BLANK AND/OR THE FORM IS NOT SIGNED, YOUR CHILD CANNOT ENTER THE CAMPUS, AND WILL HAVE TO WAIT OUTSIDE TO BE PICKED UP, OR FOR A PARENT TO COME AND SIGN THE FORM. WE WILL ARRANGE FOR AN ADULT TO SUPERVISE THEM IN THIS INSTANCE.

For the safety of all bus children, please note that if your child is sent on the bus without completing the RAT declaration form, bus service may be suspended for your child.

4. Please have your child come to school in a properly fitting mask, and prepare an extra one for their school bag. If your child refuses to wear a mask properly at school they will be unable to attend school.
5. The campus will open at 7:55am. Please line up where indicated along the school wall and avoid crowding the entrance. Please also note that due to Covid measures, all children should enter the campus on their own so that additional adults are not required to come on campus. We will



have additional staff at the door to help children walk to class, as needed. In light of this, please prepare your child to say good at the entrance.

6. For any adults coming to campus for special events such as orientation or volunteer activities, the Vaccination Pass Requirement continues to be in force, which means that adults will need to fulfil the Vaccination Pass Requirements using the Leave Home Safe App unless otherwise exempt, to enter the campus. (Pending any further changes from the government). Visitors will also need to declare that they have tested negative on RAT on the day of the visit.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Your child's health and safety are of critical importance to us! Please carefully review the attached:

- **Healthy Eating:** IMS students learn the importance of living a healthy lifestyle, including nutrition. We ask that parents support this by encouraging your child to choose, make and bring healthy food choices to school for snacks, lunch or special events. - **Safety:** Please carefully review the safety notes in the Campus Logistics. Please show your IMS Security Card to enter the campus, and collect your child at dismissal. If you do not have the security card you will need to sign the visitor register and show a Hong Kong ID.
- **Weather Warnings:** School Closure: When Hong Kong Schools close due to inclement weather, IMS will close, too. Please review the attached [Weather Warnings: School Closure Guide](#).

BUS SERVICE

Castle Brothers has already confirmed bus service for your child by mail. If you have registered for bus service and have not received your child's bus card by now, please contact Robert Mu at Castle Brothers: +852 2555 2088.

UNIFORMS

Please ensure that your child has the full uniform including backpack and hat. When children are outdoors they must be wearing a hat during school hours. Please see the attached [IMS Uniform Guide](#) for further details. If you have made a new uniform order from Aston Wilson before July 31, the uniform will be placed in your child's cubby and teachers will ensure that they take them home once school begins. Should you need to change the size, you can do so by contacting Campus Admin staff or



by visiting Aston Wilson in Kowloon. The PTA will host a **second hand uniform sale** at Mid-Levels Campus on Wednesday 17 August from 9:00am - 11:00am at the Ground Floor Lobby.
