

HEAD LICE – SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

Head Lice, Pediculosis is common among preschool-age and elementary-age children, especially in hotter regions. Frequent examination of the scalp may help you discover and treat lice before they spread. You may also consider tying up your child’s hair if it is long. Symptoms are tickling and itching sensation on the scalp. Also nits / red marks are most often found on the nape of the neck and behind the ears. Treatment of your child is not necessary unless he or she is found to have lice or nits on the scalp.
